## Vocabulary-Homophones

Use these clues to make pairs of homophones.

- 1) the present form of 'saw': <u>see</u> a synonym for 'ocean': <u>sea</u>
- 2) the special chair a king or queen sits on: <a href="mailto:throw">throme</a> another form of 'throw' that rhymes with 'bone': <a href="mailto:throw">throw</a>
- 3) the opposite of "lower": <a href="higher">higher</a>
  when you pay money to borrow something for a short time such as a car or DVD of a game: <a href="hire">hire</a>
- 4) the part of the plant that is under the ground: <u>root</u> another word which means 'way': <u>route</u>
- 5) food that is eaten with milk for breakfast: <u>cereal</u>
  a story that is shown on television in many parts: <u>serial</u>
