1) Why do you think our national movement supported the idea that all adults have a right to vote?

Answer: The freedom struggle was fought by people from different backgrounds, and the ideas of freedom, equality and participation in decision-making inspired them. The reason to fight for the nation's freedom was to live in a country governed by leaders who were sensitive to people's needs and demands and could completely abolish the inequalities under British rule. The dreams and aspirations of people to live a free and respectful life were based on the principle of Universal Adult Franchise, i.e., the right to vote.
