Introduction

- <u>Data</u>: Data is a collection of numbers, figures or names gathered to give some information.
- Raw Data: Data obtained in the original form which has not been subjected to any manipulation.
- > Observation: Each numerical figure in a data is called an observation.
- ➤ <u>Data</u>: (i) Primary Data
- (ii) Secondary Data
- (i) Primary Data Primary data is the first-hand information collected directly from the source.

Example: Survey, Observation, Experiment, etc.

(ii) Secondary Data – Secondary data is the information which has been collected in the past by someone else.

Example: Internet, Newspaper article, Websites, etc.

Organisation of Data

Organisation of Data: It is the way to arrange the raw data in an understandable form.

<u>Tabulation of Data</u>: Arranging the data in a systematic form in the form of a table is called tabulation or presentation of the data.
